


Rack Mount Monitor Tray

- (1) Partially Assembled Shelf w/ Door
- (2) Long Rear Brackets
- (2) Short Rear Brackets
- (1) Cable (PS2 to USB)
- (2) Cable Power Cord
- (10) 11" Tie Straps

- (8) 12-24 x 1/2" Pan Head Screws Zinc
- (8) 10-32 x 1/2" Pan Head Screws





Installation Instructions

Step 1. <u>Mounting Depth:</u> Measure the mounting depth for your rack from the front mounting surface to the back mounting surface




Step 2a. <u>18.2"-31.5"</u>. The rear rack brackets will be installed as shown below for this "Mounting Depth" range (See Step 3 for assembly).





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Step 2b. <u>17.5"-18.2":</u> The rear rack brackets will be installed as shown below for this "Mounting Depth" range (See Step 3 for assembly).




Step 2c. <u>11.0"-17.5"</u>. The rear rack brackets will be installed as shown below for this "Mounting Depth" range (See Step 3 for assembly).



Step 3 <u>Rear Bracket Attachment:</u> Remove outer rails from the shelf. Move the slide rails back approximately 10 inches.

Attach the Rear Rack Brackets as shown below. Attach using (4) 8-32 x 3/8" Truss Head Screws and (4) 8-32 Nuts. Tighten all screws.



 Step 4
 Attach rails to the rack:
 Attach the Front and Rear of the rails as shown using the


 "Rack Mount Hardware".
 Install cage nuts if needed. Repeat for the other side.

 Tighten screws on the right side rail.
 Leave the screws on the left side slightly loose.



Step 5 <u>Monitor Attachment:</u> Turn the monitor face down on a large flat surface. Locate the four VESA mounting holes on the rear of the monitor.
 a. <u>Determine if spacers are required:</u> Some monitors have a "recess" on the rear of the monitor. Spacers are provided to fill this gap. See Table A on page 5 for spacer length options.

b. <u>Determine Screw Length:</u> Only use the metric M4 screws provided. Screw length is determined by the spacers used (see Table A on page 5).



On-Site Manufacturing


Our manufacturing facility is on-site at our Texas headquarters. If we send them a drawing in the morning, we can have parts ready to ship-out that evening.

Step 6 <u>Install Equipment:</u> Slide the monitor shelf all the way in. Tighten all screws.



Note: When tightening the loose rails, support the bottom of the shelf to ensure proper rail adjustment.

Note: If installing CMA, refer to CMA instructions at this time.

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
