










Secure Wall-Mount Racking System

- (1) Rack Cover
- (1) Lock Bar


- (9) Drywall Anchors
- (9) 8-32 x 1.250 Pan Head Screws


Installation Instructions

Step 1. Determine the Mounting Location and Orientation: The mounting location should take into account server access, cable routing, and airflow. This rack system can be mounted in any orientation; horizontal, vertical, or any angle.

Be sure to take into account the space required for installing and removing the server.


Step 2. Mark the Mounting Locations on Wall: There are nine mounting holes on the Rack Base used for attaching to a wall. The locations are indicated below. Using the Rack Base as a template, and while holding the base on the wall in the desired locations, mark the nine hole locations on the wall.






Installation Instructions (continued)

- Step 3. <u>Install the Drywall Anchors</u>: Nine Self-Drilling Wallboard Anchors are provided with the kit for wall mounting. Install an anchor at each of the nine locations (marked in Step 2) as follows:
 - 1. Using a #2 cordless or manual screwdriver in the anchor's Phillips recess, press and turn the anchor into the drywall.
 - 2. Continue turning until the anchor is flush.
- Step 4. Attach the Rack Base to the Wall: Install the 8-32 x 1.250 Pan Head Screws through each of the nine mounting holes in the Rack Base and into the Drywall Anchors. Partially install a screw into each Anchor before tightening.



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
Step 5. Adjust the Angle Brackets: The Angle Brackets are adjustable in location, allowing various lengths of slide rails to be attached. Determine the desired location and adjust each Angle Bracket loosening the 2 screws and 2 nuts shown below. Installation of the slide rail may be simplified by leaving the Angle Bracket loose at this time, allowing the Angle Brackets to slide.




Step 6. Install Rack-Mount Rails: Most 2U Servers require some type of rackmount bracket or sliding rail. There are two main types of rack attachment holes in racks: round threaded holes and square holes. The Angle Brackets use the more common square holes. When threaded holes are required, install the 12-24 Cage nuts into the square holes. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for server rail installation.

Tighten the screws for the Angle Brackets if they were not tightened previously.

Step 7. <u>Cover Installation:</u> Place the tabs in the holes on the rear of the cover. Rotate and slide the cover into place.



Step 8. <u>Lock Bar Installation:</u> Slide the Lock Bar into place as shown below. To secure cover place lock through hole at end of Lock Bar once it is installed.
